About Connie Cleveland

Connie is an internationally recognized dog trainer who offers training seminars to competitive dog trainers and instructors around the country and overseas. Her own experience includes 11 Obedience Trial Champions (OTCH), 2 Field Champions (FC), 5 Amateur Field Champions (AFC), a UDT Maltese and a CDX Shih-Tzu.

As important as Connie's achievements in training her own dogs is her passion for teaching others. Connie taught classes to more than more than 100 students each week for over 30 years. She is the author of a DVD series, "How Dogs Learn, The Connie Cleveland Method" and a book entitled "Dogs Are Problems Solvers, Handlers Should Be."

Seminar Structure

Connie will be conducting a two-day theory/problem solving seminar. She customizes each seminar for the participants.

Before the seminar, each participant will complete a questionnaire to identify his/her personal goals and issues the dog and handler team may be having. Each participant will also receive a welcome letter from Connie with links to a video lecture presented by Connie discussing how dogs learn, as well as a digital Obedience Guide.

At the seminar, Connie works with the individual handlers and dogs. Generally, there are handlers who are having problems with, or are unsure how to teach, attention, heeling, retrieving, and recalls, so this becomes the focus of the first day. The second day, Connie will cover a variety of problems and questions, such as go-outs, articles, drop on recalls, etc.

Seminar space is limited to 20 working teams, 15 auditor spots.

Prices are as follows:

Working team = \$250 (both days)

Auditor spots (no dog) = \$125 both days; \$75 one day.

Please bring your own chair and crate for your dog.

Dogs should be crated or leash-walked outside when not working.

Continental breakfast and lunch will be provided each day.
